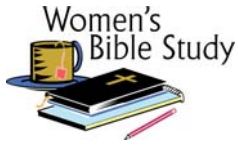

Praise the Lord! I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation. Great are the works of the Lord, studied by all who delight in them. Full of honor and majesty is his work, and his righteousness endures forever. He has gained renown by his wonderful deeds; the Lord is gracious and merciful. He provides food for those who fear him; he is ever mindful of his covenant. He has shown his people the power of his works, in giving them the heritage of the nations. The works of his hands are faithful and just; all his precepts are trustworthy. They are established forever and ever, to be performed with faithfulness and uprightness. He sent redemption to his people; he has commanded his covenant forever. Holy and awesome is his name. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding. His praise endures forever. Psalm 111

AAA is the place you call when you need directions, or for assistance when you have a breakdown on the road. AAA is also for the road of life. Authentic, Affirming, Available (AAA) adults are necessary to help young people to develop into adults of compassionate caring and faithful character. It is why we use *MENTORS* with our confirmation youth. BLC confirmation leaders seek then to match a variety of faithful adults with those young persons in confirmation who are searching for what it means to become a follower of Jesus. It is a vital and core portion of our confirmation program.

If you are a faithful adult who can and will commit to MENTORING one of our less than mature disciples, we are looking for you! We will have you meet with a designated seventh or eighth grade confirmand through the Lenten season. We desire you to be the AAA person for them. If you are a person with a positive attitude and one who isn't afraid of complimenting (Affirming), then you are sought. If you are someone who will commit to making and living up to the time for meeting and sharing with a young person (Available), then you are wanted. If you are a person who will be honest and forthright about your faith, including your doubts (Authentic), then we want you to

serve. Brief training will be provided and support offered throughout the season of Lent.

We leaders will be creating a list of BLC adults who we will ask to be *MENTORS*. We also will consider those who volunteer themselves. We may choose to invite those adults that you would recommend to us. This year we have a smaller size class (12) than some recent years. If you aren't selected as a AAA *MENTOR* this year, please know that we will consider you again as a AAA *MENTOR* for future young people. For now, we confirmation leaders ask that you pray to seek God's guidance about your participation in this ministry to the glory of God and for the sake of the world. It is said that it takes a village to raise a child. God's village called BLC needs you to help those young people who need a roadmap for living in faith and who will face breakdowns along the way of life. Will you help guide them? Let me know, or let one of the following confirmation leaders know – Jen Bronsdon, Shelly Lee, Cindy Reeson, Jeff Ziegler, Tiffany Ziegler.

ALSO - We have 10 youth, 1 college student, 3 parent chaperones, Valerie and myself registered to attend this July's National Youth Gathering in New Orleans. We are taking the train, the City of New Orleans from Chicago to New Orleans and back. We are registered with, traveling with and lodging with five other area congregations; Perry, West Blue Mounds, Immanuel, ELC, and Springdale. Our next fundraiser is the Mardi Gras Dinner at ELC in Mt Horeb on February 19th from 4-7 pm. Pancakes will also be served for those with less adventurous palates. Even though it is in Mt Horeb, please support our youth and chaperones by purchasing tickets.
